"It's been a very good year," Kevin Anderson, President and CEO of Wesley Homes, said. "We've accomplished a lot but we still have much to do."

so much to look forward to

"I'm really looking forward to being 105," said Faith Callahan. The oldest resident at Wesley Homes, Faith celebrated her 103rd birthday in October.

Faith remembers the friends and relatives who came together to celebrate her 100th birthday, and is planning a similar party for her 105th. In the meantime, she looks forward to the coming year.

"I hope to continue the activities I'm in now," she said.

Faith's list of activities is not a short one. On Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays she does an hour-long water aerobics workout. On Tuesdays and Thursdays she takes part

in YMCA exercise classes and on Saturdays she goes to the exercise room at Wesley Homes. On Sundays she attends church and visits with friends. In addition, she is a part of Dr. Simpson's book club.

"In 1972 my husband and I moved to a cottage," Faith said.

In the years since, she has seen many significant changes at Wesley Homes, but a few things have always stayed the same.

"The thing that has not changed much is the spirit of the residents," she said.

IT’S BEEN A VERY GOOD YEAR

Wesley Homes completed the Lea Hill campus in spring 2007, allowing residents to move into Eby Lodge in May. Within two months, all of the residential accommodations were assigned and most were occupied. Located in Auburn, Washington, approximately 12 miles from Wesley Homes Des Moines, the Lea Hill campus is expected to reach full occupancy in spring 2008, well ahead of projections.

In July 2007, Wesley Homes purchased TLC, a Medicare-certified home health care agency. The agency was renamed Wesley Homes At Home, and now operates as a separate entity under Wesley Homes Community Health Services. Wesley Homes At Home is able to provide services, including skilled nursing and therapy services, to individuals who qualify for Medicare or Medicaid reimbursement.

Over the course of 2007, state surveys were conducted for Wesley Homes Community Health Services, Wesley Homes Health Center, Assisted Living at Des Moines, and The Arbor at Lea Hill. The survey results indicate good quality care and few deficiencies. Overall customer satisfaction among Wesley Homes residents is very positive, and the community spirit can be seen across campuses as well as through the services Wesley Homes provides.

BUILDING NEW CAMPUSES

Growth will be a big part of Wesley Homes’ focus in the future as the organization works to create a network of services and build new communities that mirror the success of Lea Hill.

“We want to develop additional campuses with similar amenities, larger accommodations and more flexible services,” Kevin said, “all at a price that is affordable to more people.”

Kevin explained that as Wesley Homes continues its mission, philanthropy will play a greater role in strengthening the organization. “It raises money for residents, it takes care of employees, and it helps develop new programs and communities around the Puget Sound area,” he said.

Wesley Homes is also working to answer an important question: “What does it mean to live in a Wesley Homes community?” The answer to this question will define Wesley Homes’ standards and provide a clear, definable path as the organization grows.

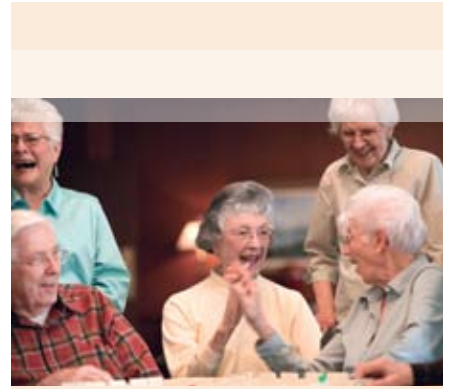
REACHING OUT TO THE COMMUNITY

The past year has brought many accomplishments that went beyond expectations for Wesley Homes Community Health Services.

"There's been so much growth it's unbelievable," Peggy Kornberg, Wesley Homes Community Health Services Board President, said. "We haven't had any backward steps, everything has seen steady growth."

The biggest growth came with the purchase of a Medicare-certified home health agency. It is rare to find such an agency for sale, and it was a difficult purchase to arrange. Once the purchase was completed, Wesley Homes rebuilt the agency from the ground up. The resulting non-profit organization, Wesley Homes At Home, is making a real difference for Wesley Homes' residents, as well as for clients in King, Pierce and Snohomish counties.

"We're able to offer home health services to people who qualify for Medicare," Kathy Matteson, Executive Director of Wesley Homes Community Health Services, said. "It's another important component in our network of services."

a career of progressive service

LaVonne Mahugh has cared for residents at Wesley Homes for over 40 years.

"I actually started in the fall of '68," LaVonne explained, "Most of the time it's been part time."

As a Wellness Nurse in The Gardens, LaVonne has seen Wesley Homes' health care capabilities grow over the years.

"The whole industry has gone through a lot of change," she said, "and definitely Wesley Homes has been a part of those changes."

In the 1970s, health care reforms changed the way retirement communities and hospitals cared for patients.

"That made a big change in the kind of patients we received," LaVonne said.

In response, Wesley Homes began making accommodations for residents with greater

health care needs. This included creating more opportunities for therapy, shared meals and social events.

"Wesley Homes was definitely on the front edge of trying to interpret what was required and get the facilities in place," LaVonne said.

LaVonne has enjoyed close relationships with many of the residents at Wesley Homes and to her they've been "almost like extended family."

"I have enjoyed seeing so many past employees who now live in Wesley Homes," she said. To LaVonne, this is the greatest testament to the community at Wesley Homes.

LaVonne would like to live at Wesley Homes someday herself, but for the time being she is looking forward to continuing to care for residents through the coming year.

"We decided to move closer to the children," Bill said, adding that the Lea Hill location has

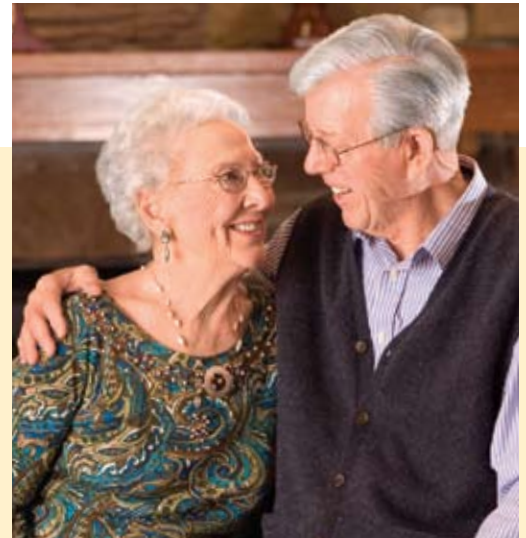
been ideal for visits from their children and grandchildren, who live both north and south of Auburn.

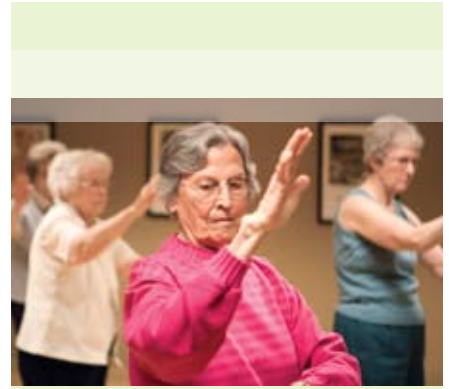
